Now in its 28th season, The Smithtown Community Band has proudly served the Smithtown township, having performed well over 100 concerts. SCB has had the pleasure of working with the Smithtown, Nesconset and Kings Park libraries, the Village of St. John's, the Smithtown Recreation Department, the Smithtown Township Arts Council, the chambers of commerce in Smithtown, St. James and Nesconset, and the dedication ceremonies for Constitutional Boulevard located at the H.
